The Sea of the Mountains Moko

Grade Levels:

K-5

Subject Areas:

Synopsis:

As Moko looked to the horizon, he saw mountains beyond the forest. He and Totemie went to see what was in the mountains. There they found a lake, there to console those who are far from the sea.

Learning Objectives: Students will:

- Enjoy the origin story presented in this program.
- Understand what a lake is.
- Evaluate Moko's reasoning and conclusions.

Vocabulary:

Lake, water, freshwater, saltwater, emissaries, endorheic lake, glacier

Pre-Viewing Discussion:

Have you ever been to the ocean? To a lake? What was your trip like?

Post-Viewing Discussion:

Who showed Moko and Totemie the lake? What did they think of the lake?

How do lakes form?

Further Activities:

Find out more about plants and animals that live in lakes and the ocean. How are they similar and how are they different?
