

Teacher's Guide

The Snow's Fury Moko

Grade Levels:

K-5

Subject Areas:

Synopsis:

On a beautiful and calm day, Moko and Alarick are headed back to the village with their catch when suddenly snow comes rushing down the mountain! They take refuge in a crack in the rocks, and creep home quietly to keep from reawakening the mountain.

Learning Objectives: Students will:

- Enjoy the origin story presented in this program.
- Understand what an avalanche is and what causes them.
- Evaluate Moko's reasoning and conclusions.

Vocabulary:

Origin story, folktale, snow, mountain, avalanche, weather

Pre-Viewing Discussion:

Have you ever seen a video of an avalanche? What does it look like? Do you think it would be scary?

Post-Viewing Discussion:

How did Moko and Alarick make it home safely?

What are some of the causes of avalanches?

Further Activities:

Research a natural event such as a famous volcano eruption, earthquake or tsunami. How are these events similar or different from the avalanche that Moko and Alarick experience? How do people cope with such disasters?
