What do all herbivore things need to survive in a habitat? What habitat would be the most difficult to survive in? Why?

CLASSROOM OR INDIVIDUAL ACTIVITIES

Have your students create and draw an imaginary planet with an imaginary ecosystem that can support herbivores that we find on earth. What herbivores would you find on the planet? What other types of life would need to grow there?
