SCIENCE ON THE NEWSHOUR: SPACE EXPLORATION **C** **D**

Grade Level: 9 - 12

In the conquest of space today, it is robots, not humans, who get the glory. This video describes missions that represent the foreseeable future in space exploration: sensor-filled craft and remotely operated devices going where people can't.
