

Teacher's Guide

The Rain Dance Moko

Grade Levels:

K-5

Subject Areas:

Reading
Writing/Composition
Media Literacy/Critical Thinking
Earth Sciences

Synopsis:

One day, Moko and Mei-Lei are in the rice fields when the sky suddenly turns dark. Mei-Lei warns Moko that they should go back to the village but Moko wants to stay. The light rain turns torrential and Mei-Lei dances until the rain stops. Moko thinks Mei-Lie's dancing is magical—it made the rain stop!

Learning Objectives: Students will:

- Enjoy the origin story presented in this program.
- Explain what causes a monsoon.
- Evaluate Moko's reasoning and conclusions.

Vocabulary:

Monsoon, precipitation, weather, climate, Asia

Pre-Viewing Discussion:

Do you like the rain? Why or why not?

What do you think causes the rain?

Post-Viewing Discussion:

Why did Moko think the rain stopped?

What causes a monsoon? When does it stop?

Further Activities:

Find out where monsoons happen and what their effect is on those areas.
